All of that parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, located about one mile south from the City of Greer, designated as Lot No. 52 on a plat of property known as Woodland Heights, property of I.M.Wood Estate, said plat made by H.S.Brockman, Surveyor, dated October 28, 1955, recorded in the R.M.C.
