KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Alleine Holliday

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Dorothy Holliday West

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Dorothy Holliday West, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, adjoining lands of J. W. Holliday, Charlie Holliday, Loran Graddy, and others, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stone, corner of lands of J. W. Holliday and Alleine Holliday and running thence along line of said J. W. Holliday S. 7-30 W. 198 feet to iron stake; thence S. E. 132 feet to iron stake on line of Loran Grady Estate; thence S. W. 198 feet to iron stake on north side of public road; thence N. 71-30 W. 132 feet to beginning corner, and containing six-tenths of one acre more or less.
