AFFIDAVIT

PERSONALLY appeared before me, George P. Roberson, who, being duly sworn, deposes and says as follows: That he and D. E. McCuen were appointed Receivers of all the rights, property and assets of W. S. Griffin by order of the Honorable H.H. Watkins, District Judge for the Western District of South Carolina, on August 24, 1928. That said District Court issued an order directing said Receivers to sell and bransfer all the property and assets of the said W. S. Griffin to Cooper and Griffin, Inc. That on November 30, 1929, the said D. E. McCuen, now deceased, and the deponent executed a deed conveying the property of the said W. S. Griffin to the said Cooper & Griffin, Inc. That said deed was executed by D. E. McCuen and George P. Roberson as Receivers of the Estate of W. S. Griffin. That said deed as recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Deed Book 170 at Page 260, in paragraph 7 of said deed, refers to D. E. McCuen and George P. Roberson as Receivers of Cooper & Griffin, Inc. That line 3 of paragraph 7 of said deed should read as follows; "we, the said George P. Roberson and D. E. McCuen, as receivers of W. S. Griffin." and that the words "the South Carolina Corporation" commencing on line 4 of paragraph 7 should not appear.
