POWER OF ATTORNEY

Know all men by these presents that we, Elliott P. Cleveland and Ann S. Cleveland, his wife, of Marietta, South Carolina, do appoint A. M. Stone of Marietta, South Carolina, our true and lawful attorney for us, and each of us, and in our name, place and stead, to grant, bargain, sell and mortgage any and all real or personal property of which we are now possessed or have any interest in or which we may hereafter acquire located in these United States of America, for such price and on such terms and to such person or persons as he, our said attorney, shall deem fit and proper, and also for us, and each of us, and in our name and as our act and deed to sign, execute, acknowledge and deliver such contract or contracts for the sale thereof, or any part thereof; also to sign, execute, acknowledge and deliver deed or deeds, either with or without covenants of warranty including therein the release of dower and homestead, and conveyance or conveyances for the absolute sale or disposal thereof or any part thereof with such clause or clauses, covenant or covenants to be therein contained as our said attorney shall deem fit and proper; also to sign, execute, acknowledge and deliver mortgage or mortgages with release of dower and homestead conveying any or all of the aforesaid premises to secure the payment of such sum or sums as our said attorney may deem fit and proper to borrow; also to sign, execute and deliver for us, and each of us, and in our name, place and stead notes and any and all other evidences of indebtedness that he, our said attorney shall deem fit and proper, and to buy and sell any bonds, stocks and other securities which our said attorney shall deem fit and proper; also to collect and receive any and all monies and property that may be due us, and to execute receipts, releases and satisfactions therefor; also to execute, deliver and cash checks drawn on any bank deposit standing in our name, and to invest, reinvest and pay
