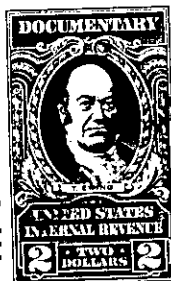

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Leslie & Shaw, Inc.

and having its principal place of business at

Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration

of the sum of Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty and no/100-----Dollars,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee
hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto James Alvin Gilreath,
his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land lying in Butler Township, lying
situate near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of
South Carolina, and known and designated as Lot #22, on the Western
side of Fairlane Circle, part of a subdivision known as Laurel Heights,
and being more particularly described according to Plat recorded in
the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book KK, at page 33,
having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at joint front corner of lots #22 and #21,
running thence along the line of these lots, N. 86-24 W. 150 feet
to an iron pin, thence N. 3-36 E. 75 feet to an iron pin, thence
S. 86-24 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Carter
Drive, thence along the Western side of Carter Drive, S. 3-36 W.
75 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning.
