All those two certain tracts of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 2 acres and .32 acres, respectively, and being separately described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin and running thence N. 61 E. 4.92 chs. to an iron pin; thence N. 23 1/4 W. 4.99 feet to a stone; thence N. 35 1/4 W. 2.70 feet to a stone; thence S. 4 1/2 W. 9.12 feet to the beginning corner, and

ALSO: That certain triangular tract adjoining the tract above described and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
