

beyond said lands.

If the Grantor shall hereafter become desirous of constructing improvements on any part of the tracts of land over a part of which the above-described right of way is granted and it is found that the transmission line of the Grantee will interfere with such proposed construction, the Cooperative shall (and hereby binds its successors and assigns so to do), upon the written request, immediately relocate so much of its line on the Grantor's property as may be necessary, so that the line will not interfere with such proposed construction; and a substituted right of way of the same width as the aforesaid is hereby granted by the Grantor for such relocation of the line, the location of the substituted right of way to be agreed upon by the parties hereto.
