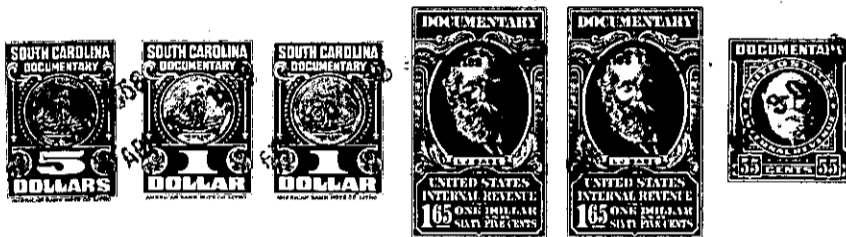
That We, William R. Lynn and Dorothy F. Lynn, in the State aforesaid,

Bishop and his heirs and assigns forever:

All of that parcel or tract of land in Highland Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, located on the northwest side of the old Few's Bridge Road, about one-half mile west from the Few's Chapel Methodist Church, having the following courses and distances:
