BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of West Parker Road at the joint
front corner of Lots # 9 and 10, and running thence along the line of said lots
S. 26-26 W. 234.8 feet to an iron pin on a service drive; thence along the
Northern side of said service drive N. 56-30 W. 75.6 feet to an iron pin; thence
