His heirs and Assigns, the following described property, to wit:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being about 15 miles south from Greenville, S. C. on a public road known as Holland Ford Road, between Ware Place and Cooley Bridge Road, on waters of Saulda River, containing Nine and seven-tenths (9.7) acres, more or less, bounded now or formerly as follows: on the North G. M. Rice and by Princess Houghe Neal, on the East by lands of Princess Hoghe Neal and by the aforesaid Holland Ford Road and on the South and West by lands of Mrs. William Wilson and being more specifically described and delineated on a plat of same prepared by J. Coke Smith, Surveyor, dated March 1, 1946, which plat is being recorded along with this deed in the R. M. C.
