

Ashe, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 110 of a subdivision known as Oak-Crest, Section II, according to a plat thereof prepared by C. C. Jones & Associates, January, 1955, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, at Pages 130-131, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Garren Drive, the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 109 and 110, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 77-04 W. 206.1 feet to an iron pin on the rear line of Lot No. 106; thence along the rear line of that lot, N. 64-42 W. 29.2 feet to an iron pin on the rear line of Lot No. 99; thence along the rear line of that lot, N. 36-27 E. 82 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lots Nos. 98 and 111; thence along the line of Lot No. 111, N. 78-25 E. 170.6 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Garren Drive; thence along the western side of Garren Drive, S. 11-23 E. 20.4 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the western side of Garren Drive, S. 12-56 E. 49.6 feet to the beginning corner; being a portion of the property conveyed to Brown, Inc., by George F. Townes, individually and as trustee, by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 517 at Page 25.
