WHEREAS, on December 20, 1910, Jacob W. Cagle of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, departed this life testate, and under the provisions of his Will, J. W. Cagle, grandson of the said Jacob W. Cagle, received certain property interest by bequest and devise; and

WHEREAS, a part of the property in which the said J. W. Cagle received an interest consists of a certain block or group of stores in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, which said block or group of stores is known and designated as the "Cagle Block" and is located at the corner of Main Street and McBee Avenue, in the said City; and

WHEREAS, sometime prior to May 7, 1956, the said J. W. Cagle assigned unto Beatrice Cagle for and during her natural life an undivided one-twelfth (1/12) interest in and to the net income to be derived from the lease and rental of the said property known and designated as the "Cagle Block", as hereinabove set out, which said interest was all the interest in and to the said block of stores that the assignor, J. W. Cagle, had at the time of the assignment; and

WHEREAS, after the assignment of the said one-twelfth (1/12) interest to the said Beatrice Cagle as is hereinabove set out, the said J. W. Cagle received other interest in and to the said block of stores and other property inherited through the Will of his grandfather, Jacob W. Cagle; and

WHEREAS, on May 7, 1956 the said J. W. Cagle conveyed unto his sister, Mabel Virginia Cagle (subject to the assignment of the undivided one-twelfth (1/12) interest in and to

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
