

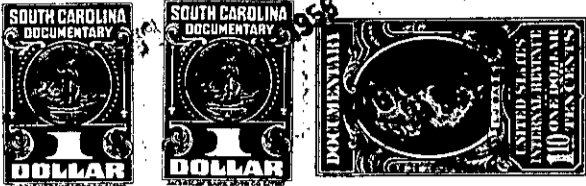

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Harold David Hill and his heirs and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located on the east side of the St. Mark Road about one mile north of Taylors, lying in the intersection of the St. Mark Road and a new street, being all of Lot No. 9 as shown on a plat of property made for J.A. Bull by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated April 12, 1946, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "X", at page 132, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the intersection of St. Mark Road and street, and runs thence with the margin of said street, N. 52-17 E. 155 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 37-00 W. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 52-17 W. 155.1 feet to an iron pin on the edge of the St. Mark Road; thence with said road, S. 37-05 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
