Parcel Number 2.

Parcel Number 3.

Billingsley, L.S. No. 1161 from survey of October 1957. Said Monroe tract Number 3 containing Fifty three (53) acres, more or less.

Parcel Number 4.

All that tract, piece or parcel of land, lying, being and situate in Laurens and Greenville Counties and State of South Carolina, containing Two hundred forty five (245) acres, more or less, being bounded on the Northwest and Northeast by lands now or formerly of West Virginia Pulp and Paper Company, and on the North and East by lands now or formerly of Knight, and on the South by lands now or formerly of Taylor, branch being the line, and on the Southwest and West by Saluda River, being shown and delineated as Monroe tract Number 4, by plat of survey of John C. Billingsley, L.S. No. 1161 from survey of October 1957.
