All that piece, parcel or lot of land on the Western side of Webster Street in the village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., at Slater, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 6 of Block G, as shown on a plat of the village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., made by J. E. Sirrine & Co. Engineers, July 10, 1940, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book K at Page 63, 64 and 65 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
