	and to construct and maintain in, upon and through said premises, in a proper manner, a pipe line or lines, air vents, blow off connections manholes and other necessary apparatus incident thereto, using the necessary appliances and machinery for such work for the purpose of conveying water through the premises above described, together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line or lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of the same.
