CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

JAMES B. ORDERS, JR., and ELIZABETH M. THOMSON

All of Greenville, S. C.

two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of

FAMILY AND CHILDREN SERVICE OF GREENVILLE COUNTY
(Greenville, S. C.)

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 28th day of

November, A. D. 1958, file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the Greenville News-Piedmont, a newspaper published in the

County of Greenville, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is

FAMILY AND CHILDREN SERVICE OF GREENVILLE COUNTY

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is GREENVILLE, S. C.

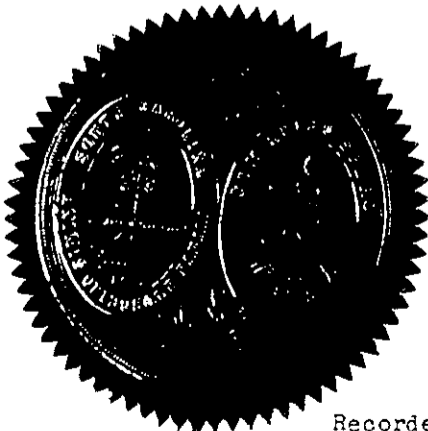
FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to serve the community as a non-profit charitable and eleemosynary corporation, as follows: (a) Wherever possible, to restore disadvantaged families to social self-sufficiency and a normal life, by means of careful planning and carrying out such plans, which may involve relief, employment, medical care, education and the solution of family difficulties of all kinds whether due to internal or external causes; (b) To provide a temporary institutional home for dependent children or those needing any special service who are residing in Greenville County; to provide foster family care for children, to provide placement of children for adoption, and to provide services to families with problems relating to the welfare of their children; (c) To serve as a co-operative center for all agencies interested in the various phases of family and children work.

FIFTH: The names and residences of all Managers, Trustees, Directors or other officers are as follows:

SIXTH: That they desire to be incorporated: In perpetuity.

Now, Therefore, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested, by Chapter 12, Title 12, Code of 1952, and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby declare the said organization to be a body politic and corporate, with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities, conferred by said Chapter 12, Title 12, Code of 1952, and Acts amendatory thereto.
