(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bud B. Pitman, and his heirs and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the East side of the road leading from the Landrum-Oak Grove Road to State Highway No. 14.

BEGINNING at a corner of Billy Campbells' land and running with Campbell's line S-72 3/4 W. about 85 yards to the road; thence with the line of the road North about 200 yards to Crowell Pitman home tract; thence with his home place line Northeast about 114 yards to an iron pin in R. E. McClure's line; thence with McClure's line S-41 E. 390 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with McClure's line East about 85 yards to McClure's and Campbell's corner; thence with Campbell's line about 160 yards to the BEGINNING, containing five acres more less.
