All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Northern side of E. Coffee Street, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Northeastern corner of the intersection of E.Coffee Street and Brown Street, and running thence with the Eastern side of Brown Street in a Northerly direction 150 feet to a stake; thence in an Easterly direction along the lot now or formerly of Mrs. Lillie L. Reilly 100 feet to a stake; thence in a Southerly direction along lot now or formerly of James Finlay Estate 150 feet to a stake on the Northern side of E.
