to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Henry C. Harding, his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot No. 17 of Indian Hills, plat of which is recorded in the RMC office for Greenville County in plat book QQ at page 11, and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Hiwassee Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 17 and 18, and running thence with the line of said lots, N. 80-30 E., 175 feet; thence S. 9-30 E., 90 feet; thence S. 80-30 W., 175 feet to an iron pin on Hiwassee Drive; thence with Hiwassee Drive, N. 9-30 W., 90 feet to the point of beginning. This conveyance is made subject the recorded restrictions applicable to Indian Hills.
