And generally:

To perform all and every act, deed, matter, and thing whatsoever in and about my estate, property, and affairs, as fully as I might or could do in my own proper person, the above specifically enumerated powers being in aid of the full, complete, and general power herein granted and not in limitation thereof; and I hereby ratify all my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of this power.
