FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is SCREEN ART ADVERTISING, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is making and printing signs, silk screen printing, hand lettering, art work and designing; and to do any and all things generally done in a business of this type.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Twenty-Five Hundred (\$2500.00)------Dollars payable all paid in.

SINTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Twenty-five (25)

of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00)----- Dollars.

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent, of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice

of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greenville Piedmont

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville
