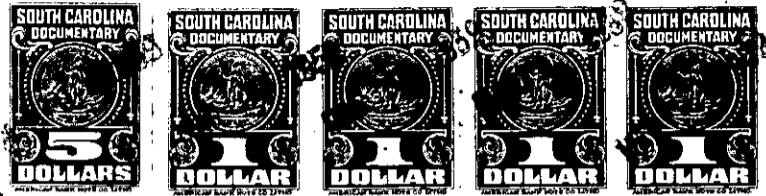

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That **GLOUCESTER LUMBER COMPANY**
a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of **North Carolina**
and having its principal place of business at **Rosman**
in the State of **North Carolina**, for and in consideration of the
sum of

Four Thousand Five Hundred & no/100 (\$4,500.00) - - - - - dollars,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto **THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, S.C.**, its successors and assigns, forever:

ALL of the right, title and interest of the grantor herein, in and to all timber rights, easements for ingress and egress, privileges to remove felled timber, and all other interests of whatsoever nature, whether the same be considered realty or personalty, lying and being within the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, acquired under a deed or agreement entered between Gloucester Lumber Company as purchaser, and W.H. Corbett and Wadell Corbett, partners, t/a Corbett Bros. as sellers, which instrument is dated March 2, 1950, and is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Deed Book 412, at page 406, referencē to which is hereby made.

It is the intention of the grantor to convey all timber rights and other interests owned or claimed by the said grantor in Greenville County, S.C. which were acquired or claimed to have been acquired through the timber deed or agreement referred to above.
