

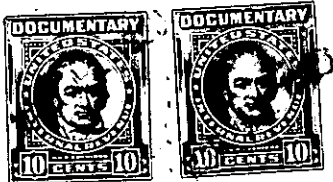

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Rex, Inc.

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina

and having its principal place of business at

Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration

of the sum of One Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Dollars,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee

hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and

released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Levis L. Gilstrap and Lloyd W. Gilstrap, their heirs and assigns forever

All of that lot of land situate near the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known as lots 173 and 183, part of Avon Park, according to plat by C. C. Jones, dated December, 1956, plat of which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, plat book KK at page 71 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

#173:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northeast side of Trent Drive at joint front corner of lots 173 and 174, running thence along the line of these lots, N 36-51 E, 150.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S 80-59 E, 90.5 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of lots 172 and 173, S 36-51 W, 193 feet to an iron pin on the northeast side of Trent Drive; thence along Trent Drive, N 53-09 W, 80 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning.

#183:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southeast side of Trent Drive at joint front corner of lots 182 and 183, running thence along the line of these lots S 36-51 W, 220 feet to a branch; thence following the meanders of a branch, the traverse line of which is N 51-00 W, 80 feet to an iron pin at rear of lots 183 and 184, running thence N 36-51 E, 230 feet to an iron pin on the southeast side of Trent Drive; thence along Trent Drive, N 53-09 W, 80 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning.

Being the same conveyed the grantor by deed book 577 at page 516.

This deed is executed pursuant to a Resolution of the Board of Directors of Rex, Inc., held on March 10, 1959.
