That Caroline E. Mason in consideration of the sum of One and 40/100 (\$1.00) and correction of deed to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Laurie Parr Moseley and John Charles Barnett, their heirs and assigns forever;

ALL THAT CERTAIN piece, parcel or tract of land, triangular in shape, situate, lying and being on Gap Creek Road in Cleveland Township, state and county aforesaid, and having, according to a plat made by R. K. Campbell, Surveyor, February, 1955, recorded in the R. M. C. Office of Greenville County in Plat Book "44" at page 41, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin located near the edge of Gap Creek Road and running thence N. 47-49 W. 330.4 feet along the line of Gladys Carter Howard Property (formerly owned by W. A. Johnson) to an iron pin in dogwood stump located on the N. W. side of Schoolhouse Creek; thence running N. 29-30 E. 103.4 feet along line of property formerly owned by Gladys Carter Howard, now owned by the grantees herein, to an iron pin located by a sweet gum tree; thence running S. 20-40 E. 410.8 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

THE PURPOSE of this deed being to clarify and correct a conveyance of the same property as conveyed by the grantor herein to Gladys Carter Howard by deed recorded in Deed Book 503 at page 257 on the 15th day of October, 1953, in the R. M. C. Office of Greenville County, South Carolina, said property having been subsequently conveyed to the grantee herein by Gladys Carter Howard TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named and their Heirs and Assigns forever. And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness the grantor's(s) hand and seal this 20th day of March in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-nine.
