(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John D. Huff, his heirs and assigns, forever

all that piecesparcelsor lotsof land in Dunklin Township Township,

County, State of South Carolina and described as follows:

TRACT NO.1 A tract of land now containing twenty-three and one-half acres, more or less, being the remaining part of a sixty-one and three-fourths acre tract which is described from a plat made by J. M. Cox, dated September 8, 1897 as follows:

BEGINNING at a stone at the northwest corner of said tract and running S. 8 E. 45.65 to a stake; thence N. 89 E. 11.80 to a Maple; thence N. 17 W. 4.50 to an angle; thence N. 13 W. 9.85 to an angle; thence N. 4 E. 4.20 to a corner in road; thence N. 46 W. 82 to a stone; thence S. 89 1/2 W. 5.85 to a stone; thence N. 14 1/2 E. 24.70 to a stone; thence N. 86 1/2 W. 9 to corner; thence N. 43 W. 2.10 to a persimmon tree and stone corner; thence N. 86 1/2 W. 8.50 to the beginning corner. This is the identical tract conveyed to W. V. Campbell by deed of R. K. Stringer recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Vol. 21, at Page 391. Excluded from the foregoing is a tract of 38 1/4 acres conveyed by W. V. Campbell to A. L. Campbell by deed recorded in Vol. 71 at Page 407. It is the intention of the grantors to convey the remainder of said 61 3/4 acre tract to the grantee and particularly all of said tract lying South of the creek which bisects the property.

TRACT NO. 2: Lying on the Cooley and Dunklin Bridge Road, on waters of Horse Creek:

BEGINNING at a stone on Mrs. Jane Daniels and S. J. Tumbling and running thence S. 67 E. 7.29 to a stone near branch; thence S. 1 1/2 E. 17.00 to a stone in old road; thence N. 75 1/2 E. 14.05 to a stone on road; thence N. 78 1/2 E. 6.35 to a stone on road; thence S. 2 W. 19.34 to a stone on Tumbling; thence S. 81 W. .81 to stone; thence N. 74 W. 18.50 to a stone; thence S. 40 3/4 W. 12.58 to the beginning corner, containing 51.49 acres, more or less, and being the identical tract conveyed to W. V. Campbell by deed of Robert L. Davenport recorded in Vol. ZZZ at Page 212.

TRACT NO. 3: Containing 5/8 acre beginning on stone in old road and thence N. 75 1/2 E. 14.00 to a stone; thence S. 20 3/4 W. 8.50 to stone; thence S. 76 1/4 W. 8.66 to stone; thence N. 1 1/2 W. .56 to the beginning corner and being the identical tract conveyed to W. V. Campbell by deed of O. B. Davenport recorded in Vol. 21 at page 387.

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
