FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is DURHAM AND QUINN BUILDERS, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Bramlett Road, GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is construct buildings of all types, repair and remodel buildings of all types, buy and sell building supplies and materials and related supplies and materials, to buy, sell and mortgage real estate and to do all other acts which a corporation may do under the laws of South Carolina.
