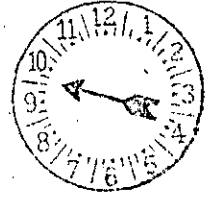

to me paid by Eugene Waytt Mull
in the State aforesaid (Receipt of which is hereby acknowledged)

have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Eugene Waytt Mull, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, lying and being on the
northerly side of Columbia Avenue, near the City of Greenville, S.C., be-
ing shown as Lot No. 8 on the plat of the sub-division for E. B. Willis,
Jr., recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book
JJ, page 65, and having according to said plat the following metes and
bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northerly side of Columbia Avenue at a
point 148 feet east of the northeasterly corner of the intersection of
Columbia Avenue and Hill Street, said pin being the joint front corner
of Lots 7 and 8, and running thence along the joint line of said lots N
10-47 E 107 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot 10; thence with the
line of Lot 10 and the line of Lot 9 S 56-06 E 157.9 feet to an iron pin;
thence S 23-21 W 46 feet to an iron pin on the northerly side of Columbia
Avenue; thence along the northerly side of Columbia Avenue N 79-13 W 135
feet to the point of beginning.
