to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said McDonald McCall, his heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, known as a portion of the land conveyed to J. M. McCall, decedent, by W. T. Newby; by Deed recorded in Deed Book 244 at Page 26 and having, according thereto, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING in the White Horse Road, thence running S. 41 1/2 W., 2.95 to a stone C.H.; thence S. 62 3/4 W., 7.82 to a stone; thence running S. 7 1/2 W. 5.55 to a stone on branch; thence running S. 66 3/4 W., 2.00 to a stone; thence running N. 77 1/8 W., 26.30 to a stone C.H.; thence running N. 81 3/4 W., 5.70 to the center of settlement road; thence running with said road N. 43 1/4 E., 14.05 to a bend; thence running N. 36 E., 5.80 to a bend; thence running N. 30 W., 4.47 to an iron pin in said road; thence running S. 83 E., 26.11 to center of White Horse Road; thence with said road S. 4 W., 4.00 to a bend; thence running S. 9 W., 6.70 to the beginning;
