Strahlem, his heirs and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot 269, on Plat of Section 3, of Belle Meade, plat of which is recorded in Plat Book GG, page 187, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northside of Pine Creek Drive at the joint corner of Lots 268 and 269; and running thence N. 13-10 E. 121.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 65-50 E. 49.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 36-28 E. 80.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 12-36 W. 102 feet to an iron pin on the northside of Pine Creek Drive; thence along Pine Creek Drive N. 75-10 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
