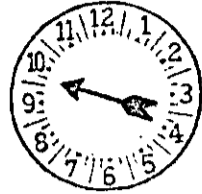

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Virgil A. Henson and Hattie Jane Henson, their heirs and assigns

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in old Appalachian Highway at the Southeast corner of Lot Number Two and running North 19 deg. 18 min. East, with the line of Lot Number Two, 211.5 feet to a stake in Julian Calhoun line, and old Southern Railroad Roadbed; thence with Calhoun's line and the old roadbed South 74 deg. 50 min. East 339.2 feet to an iron pin; thence South 28 deg. 40 min. West 199.1 feet to a stake in South side of old Appalachian Highway (an iron pin offset in line 29 feet from corner); thence North 77 deg. 40 min. West 300 feet to the BEGINNING corner, containing 1.47 acres, more or less.  
 Being all of Lot Number One (1) as shown on plat made by A. G. McMurray, Surveyor, dated July 15, 1953.
