did on the 14th day of January, 1959, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is ATLAS VENDING CO., INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is 229 Augusta Street, Greenville, South Carolina

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to conduct a general vending business for the sale and dispensation by means of mechanical devices and machines of all types of merchandise, foods, beverages, candies, cigarettes and sundries; to buy and sell (at wholesale or retail), lease, hold, operate and maintain mechanical vending machines of all types normally incident to the operation of said business; and to do any and all things reasonably necessary or conducive to the furtherance of said business.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00) -----Dollars payable in cash or by the transfer of assets of an equivalent value

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is ten thousand (\$10,000.00) of the par value of Ten (\$10.00) -----Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 30th day of October, 1956, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: Alex Kiriakides, Jr., George Kiriakides and John Kiriakides

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Alex Kiriakides, Jr.; as Vice President, George Kiriakides; as Secretary, John Kiriakides; as Treasurer, Alex Kiriakides, Jr.

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville Piedmont

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to conduct business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Secretary of State and in the office of the Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
