C. on the Eastern side of the White Horse Road, and being known and designated as Lot No. 4 of the Property of William Green, according to a Plat thereof made by C. C. Jones & Associates, Engineers, dated April 26, 1955, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit: all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township,
