All that piece, parcel or lot of land just outside city limits of Greenville near White Horse Road on Easley Highway # 29, in subdivision known as Rolando Hills, according to plat made July, 1950 by Piedmont Engineering Company, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in plat Book "AA" at page 71, this being a portion of the above property which was not numbered at the time said plat was made, but which was subdivided by J. C. Hill on June 23, 1959 and which he has called lots 24, 25 and 26, Block D, the lot herein deeded being lot number 25, according to said plat by J. C. Hill, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Ashland Drive, at the joint corner of lots 25 and 26, which joint corner is 150 feet West of the intersection of Vincent Avenue, and Ashland Drive; thence continuing along said Ashland Drive, S. 60-25 W. 30 feet to an iron pin; thence in the same direction along said Ashland Drive, 58.6 feet to an iron pin; the joint front corner of lots 24 and 25; thence N. 11-30 W. 262.2 feet to an iron pin in the center of Old Railroad Bed; thence N. 59-E. 160.4 feet, the center of Old Railroad Bed to an iron pin; thence S. 1-25 W. 299.1 feet to an iron pin on Ashland Drive, the point of beginning.

Grantee herein to pay taxes for the year 1959.
