H. NORRIS and NORA R. NORRIS, their heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the Southeast side of Friartuck Road, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot 64 on plat of Sherwood Forest, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August 1951, revised through November 1952, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book GG, pages 70 and 71 (also recorded in Plat Book BB, pages 30 and 31), and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Friartuck Road at joint front corner of Lots 63 and 64 and running thence along the line of Lot 63, S. 48-56 E., 140 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 20-48 E., 30 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 65, N. 87-17 W., 181.6 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Friartuck Road; thence with the curve of Friartuck Road (the chord being N. 30-21 E., 129 feet) to the beginning corner.
