KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, JANIE H. FORRESTER, S. M. FORRESTER, HERBERT FORRESTER, SUSAN F. RUCKER and RAYMOND L. RUCKER, of said County and State, for and in consideration of the premises, and of the sum of One and no/100 (\$1.00) Dollar to us in hand paid by WOOTEN CORPORATION OF WILMINGTON, a South Carolina Corporation, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said Wooten Corporation of Wilmington, its successors and assigns, the right, privileges and easement to go in and upon that tract of land, situated in Austin Township, in the said County and State, bounded by Forrester Drive on the East and South side and by the C. & W. C. Railroad on the West side, about two miles Northeast of the Town of Mauldin, said tract consisting of approximately 218 acres and belongs to the grantors, Janie H. Forrester, S. M. Forrester, Herbert Forrester, and Susan F. Rucker, and inherited from I.H. Forrester, see Apartment 615, File 59, in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, S.C. Also a tract of land situate on the West side of Forrester Road about two miles Northeast of the Town of Mauldin, fronting on said Forrester Road 209 feet and containing approximately 1 acre which belongs to the grantors, Raymond L. Rucker and Susan F. Rucker and was acquired by them under deed of Isaac H. Forrester, dated October 18, 1950, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Deed Book 421, page 372, and to construct and maintain in, upon and through said premises, in a proper manner, a pipe line or lines, air vents, blow off connections, manholes and other necessary apparatus incident thereto, using the necessary appliances and machinery for such work for the purpose of conveying water through the premises above described, together with the right at all times to enter upon

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
