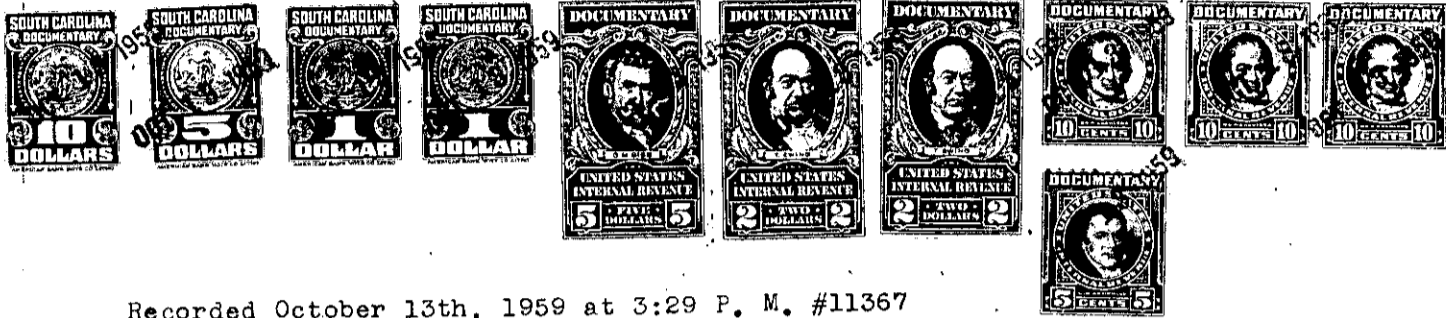


feet to angle in near Persimmon tree; thence N-9-1/2-W 486 feet along Garrison line to point of beginning.
