It being my intention to convey to the said Flora Mae Long or to assign to her all of my interest in said company and by this instrument she is to receive any and all interests or inheritance that I have in said company and by this instrument I do hereby further request and agree that all stock, if any, to be issued to me by way of inheritance or otherwise be issued to my mother, Flora Mae Long.
