Know All Men by These Presents:

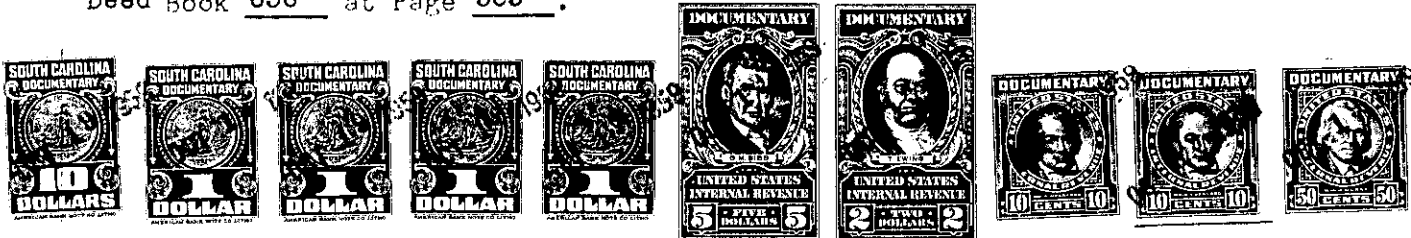

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Oscar Thomas Gibbs, Jr., his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 2 on plat of property of P. L. and Pauline B. McHugh, made by C. O. Riddle, Surveyor, October 6, 1959, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book IT at Page 53, and, according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the westerly side of White Horse Road, (S. C. Highway No. 250), at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, and running thence with the line of said lots, S. 69-59 W., 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 20-01 W., 70 feet to an iron pin; thence with line of Lot No. 3, N. 69-59 E., 200 feet to iron pin on White Horse Road; thence with White Horse Road, S. 20-01 E., 70 feet to the point of beginning.
