All our right, title, interest and estate in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the Town of Travelers Rest, on the east side of Buncombe Road or Main Street, in the County of Greenville, South Carolina, being Lots Nos. 9 and 10 on plat made by E. M. Hunt, Surveyor, dated March and May, 1891, of the lands of R. W. Anderson, deceased, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on said Main Street and running thence S. 2 E., 100 feet; thence N. 872 E., 337 feet to a stake on east side of branch; thence N. 27 W., 100 feet to a stake on west side of branch; thence S. 87 W., 337 feet to the point of beginning.
