in writing within sixty (60) days of resignation, failure to qualify or death of the originally-named Trustee, or Trustees; shall be consented to in writing by the new nominee; and shall be recorded in the R. M. C. Office, Greenville County, South Carolina. In default of the exercise of this power of appointment, any single Trustee, or if there be no such single Trustee then any interested party, may apply to the Court having jurisdiction for the appointment of a Trustee, or Trustees hereunder.

- as they retain only the above described property or any substituted property as a home, but in the event any cash or securities are delivered to them, they shall post the bond required by fiduciaries under the laws of the State of South Carolina, and continue to post bond so long as they hold any cash or securities of said trust estate, and to pay the premiums from the income of said property, if sufficient, if not, from the principal held by them.
- McDaniel, or until she remarries, and until her youngest named child reaches twenty-one (21) years of age at which time the corpus and income shall be distributed and the trust terminated. The children of Mary Ann McDaniel and Jerome C. McDaniel to take hereunder are: William Dean McDaniel, age four (4) years; Mary Pamela McDaniel, age three (3) years, and Jerome Warren McDaniel, age two (2) years. They are to share and share alike in said distribution of said funds or property. If either of said children die before the distribution date herein provided for, leaving no child or children, his, or her, portion shall be divided between the surviving children, or, if only one, to the survivor. The child or children of a deceased parent shall receive the portion the parent would have received if living. In the event none of the said children are surviving at the time of distribution and they leave no child or children to take hereunder, then the same shall be distributed to Mary Ann McDaniel, if surviving. If not, the same shall
