STARSDALE MANOR

The following protective covenants and building restrictions are hereby imposed upon all lots in a subdivision known as STARSDALE MANOR, property of P. L. Bruce, T. S. Bruce, and Nora P. Bruce, as shown on plat thereof made by Dalvon & Neves, March 1956, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book NN page 9.

These covenants and restrictions are to run with the land and shall be binding on all parties and all persons claiming under them for a period of 25 years from the date these covenants are recorded, at which time said covenants shall automatically terminate unless a majority of the then owners of the loss shall agree in writing to extend said covenants for such period of time as they may see fit.

Invalidation of any one of these covenants by judgment or Court order shall in no wise affect any of the other provisions which shall remain in full force and effect.

Enforcement shall be by proceedings at law or in equity agains, any persons or persons violating or attemption to violate any covenant, either to restrain violation or to recover damages.

- 1. All lots in said subdivision shall be used for residential purposes only. No building shall be erected, altered, placed or permitted to remain on any lot other than one detached single family dwelling, not to exceed two stories in height and a private garage for not more than 2 cars.
- 2. No dwelling shall be erected or permitted on any lot at a cost of less than \$6,000 based upon cost levels prevailing on the date these covenants are recorded, it being the intention and purpose of this covenant to assure that all dwellings shall be of quality, workmanship, and materials substantially the same or better than that which can be produced on the date these covenants are recorded at the minimum cost stated herein for the minimum permitted dwelling size. The ground floor area of the main structure, exclusive of one story open porches and agrages, shall be not less than 900 square feet for a more than one story.
- 3. No building shall be located on any loc nearer to the front lot line or nearer to the side street line than the minimum building set back lines shown on the recorded plat, or located nearer than 5 feet to any side lot line or rear line. No fence, hedgerow, or wall, except a retaining wall, shall be erected, placed or altered on any lot nearer to any street than the minimum building set back line.
- 4. No residential low shall be subdivided or recut to face any other direction than that shown on said place. No dwelling shall be erected or placed on any low which has been reduced in size greater than 20% from that which is now shown on said recorded place, or which may then have less than 85 feet frontage on Starsdale Circle.
- 5. No concrete blocks shall be used in the construction of a dwelling on any residential loc which may be visible from the front building line of said lot after grading has been completed. No noxious or offensive trade or activity shall be carried on upon any loc, nor shall anything be done thereon which may be or become a nuisance to the neighborhood.
