Underwood, Jr. and Martha H. Underwood, their heirs and assigns forever.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the northerly side of Runyon Drive, near the City of Greenville, S. C., and being designated as Lot No. 16 on the plat of Pine Brook Extension as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book W, page 73, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
