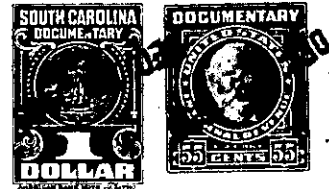

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Eva Clinkscale

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Spring Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina Being a part of that tract or parcel of land known as the A.C. Wood Tract, situated on the south side of a branch having its source near the home of John Bridwell, Branch waters of Enoree River, adjoining lands of James Parker, John Brodwell, R.L. Goodwin, and having the following metes and bounds;

Beginning on iron pin 3x on John Bridwell line, thence N. 80 E. 7.00 Chains to iron pin in a cleared field 3xnn. thence N. 32 1/8 W. 9.00 Chains to iron pin on James Parker Line 3xnn, Thence with James Parker Line S. 80 W. 7.00 to iron Pin on north side of Branch 3xnn, thence with Bridwell line S. 32 1/8 E. 5.00 chains to beginning corner, and containing three and one half (3 1/2) Acres more or less According to survey made By.
