

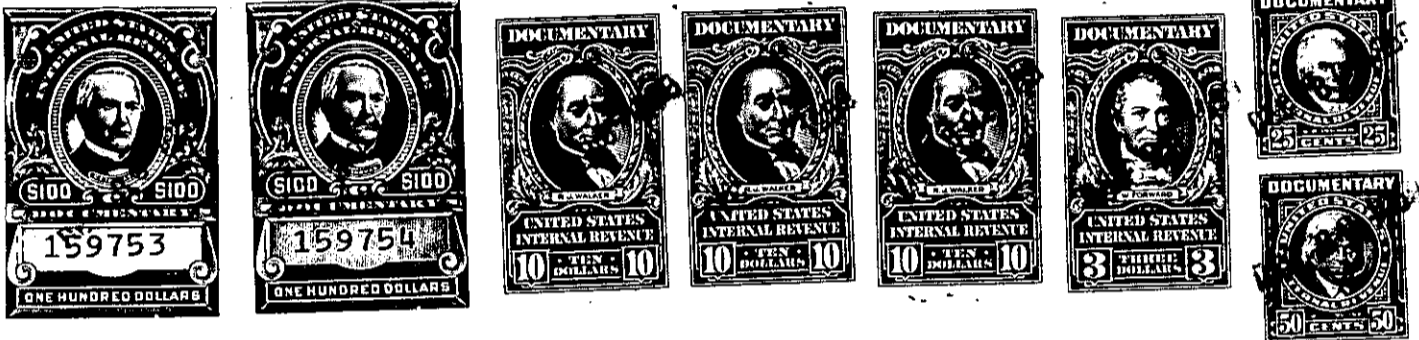
The above-described property was acquired by the grantor herein as follows:
