"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the northerly side of Old Easley Bridge Road, being shown and designated as Lot No. Three (3) on plat of Plainview Heights made by Jones & Sutherland, Engineers, dated March 6,1959, and thereon more fully described as follows: BEGINKING at iron pin on Easley Bridge Road, common corner of the lot herein conveyed and Lot 2, running thence along line of Lot 2 North 37-54 West 171.3 feet to iron pin; running thence along line of Lot 4 South 40-06 West 102.2 feet to iron pin on Plainview Drive; thence with Plainview Drive South 37-54 East 125 feet to iron pin; thence around the intersection of Plainview Drive and Easley Bridge Road South 82-54 East 33.4 feet to iron pin on Easley Bridge Road; thence with Easley Bridge Road North 52-06 East 75 feet to the BEGINLING corner; being a portion of the land conveyed to A.
