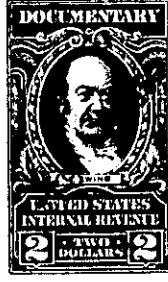
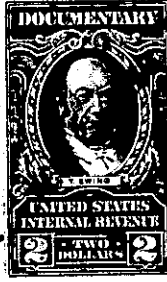
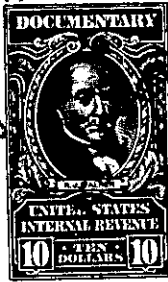

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 4 on plat of Chestnut Hills No. 1, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "MM", at page 107 and in Plat Book "QQ", page 83, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Bear Grass Drive, said iron pin being the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 3 and 4 and being 180 feet from the intersection of Bear Grass Drive and Folkstone Street, and running thence with Bear Grass Drive, S. 15-41 W. 80 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 74-19 W. 147.6 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 115; thence N. 17-33 E. 80.04 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 114; thence S. 74-19 E. 145 feet to an iron pin on the west edge of Bear Grass Drive, the point of beginning.
