of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$400.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said J. Y. Sloan, H. E. Pigg, W. E. Rollins, as Trustees for The
Church of God of Prophecy of Greer, S. C., their Successors and Assigns
forever, in and to the following described real estate:

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State
of South Carolina, located about two miles south of Gowansville, on west
side of Goodjoin Road.
BEGINNING at an iron pin in center of said Goodjoin Road, and runs
thence with said road N. 34.05 W. 330 feet to cross roads, thence with
the Wingo Road S. 19.30 W. 596 feet to an iron pin in the center of said
Wingo road; thence N. 53.05 E. 483 feet to the beginning corner and con-
tains 1.82 acres, more or less as per survey of J. H. Atkins, Surveyor,
