All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, in Cleveland Township, County and State aforesaid, being located about 24 miles north of Greenville Court House, near the Old Jones Gap Road, on the north side of Middle Saluda River, containing 1.65 acres, more or less, and having the following courses and distances, according to a survey made by W. A. Hester, dated May 20, 1927:

BEGINNING at a stake on the north bank of Middle Saluda River, corner of land now belonging to Murphy and Nalley, and running thence in an easterly direction along said River, 144 feet, more or less, to corner of property now belonging to Collins, formerly Peace; thence with the line of said property N 2 E 812 feet to a stake and stone; thence S 15-45 W 343 feet to an iron pin; thence S 9-45 W 499 feet to the point of beginning.
