CHARTER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

GREENVILLE SO. S. C.

did on the 15th day of March, 19 60, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is LESLIE ADVERTISING AGENCY

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to transact the business of advertising, promoting, and developing the business of other corporations, partnerships, or individuals for hire, or upon commission, or otherwise, by and through the means of preparing advertising for other corporations, partnerships, or individuals, and of advertising the business, commodities, or other property, real, personal, or mixed, of other corporations, partnerships, or individuals on television, radio, in newspapers, books, booklets, prospectuses, magazines, displays, circulars, pamphlets, or other similar literature and advertising media; and to do all things ordinarily incident to the conduct of such business. Also to purchase, or otherwise acquire, own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign and transfer or otherwise dispose of real and personal property of every class and description.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00)-----Dollars payable in cash or property at the call of the directors.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Two Thousand (2,000) of the par value of Ten (\$10.00)-----Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 11th day of February, 19 60, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: William A. Leslie and Bill B. Bozeman

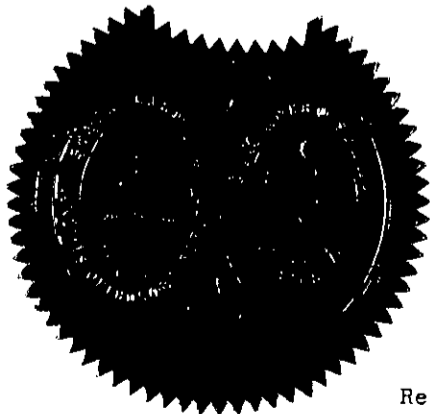
EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, William A. Leslie ; as Vice-President, Bill B. Bozeman ; as Secretary, Bill B. Bozeman ; as Treasurer, William A. Leslie

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greenville Piedmont

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I. O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
